

Bibigo's Mandu Prawn Dumplings recalled due to undeclared egg allergen


Food manufacturer, CJ Cau Tre, has voluntarily recalled Bibigo's Mandu Prawn Dumplings (350g) and Mini Mandu Prawn Dumplings (360g) from Vietnam, due to undeclared egg allergen.

2 As egg is an allergen, and the implicated products were imported into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has directed the importer, CJ SE Asia Pte Ltd, to recall the implicated products. The recall is ongoing.

3 Allergen in food could result in allergic reaction in individuals who are sensitive to it. Under Singapore's Food Regulations, food products containing ingredients that are known to cause hypersensitivity must be declared on food packaging labels to protect consumers with food allergies.

4 Egg does not pose a food safety issue to consumers at large, except for those that are intolerant of, or allergic to, egg. Consumers who have purchased the affected products, and who are intolerant of, or allergic to, egg, should not consume them. Those who are intolerant of, or allergic to, egg and have consumed the implicated products should seek medical advice if they have concerns about their health. Consumers may contact their point of purchase for enquiries.
