



Consumer advisory on infant milk powder products available in Singapore

Issued on 5 August 2013

Following Fonterra's [alert](#) that some batches of its whey protein concentrate may have been contaminated by the bacteria Clostridium botulinum, AVA has confirmed that there has been **no import of the affected Fonterra brand dairy products from New Zealand to Singapore.**

2 However, Danone Dumex has voluntarily recalled two batches of Mamil Gold PreciNutri™ Step 2 After 6 Months Follow-up Formula (refer to Annex A for details) as a [precautionary measure](#). **Other infant milk powder products available in Singapore are not affected.**

3 Consumers who have purchased the affected products should not feed it to their infants and should instead contact Danone Dumex at 1800-265-3188 or careline@dumex.sg for a full refund or exchange. Consumers who have already been using the affected products and who may be concerned about its effects on their infants should consult a doctor.

4 As part of AVA's routine surveillance and inspection programme, imported food products, including infant milk powder and dairy products, are regularly monitored and sampled for food safety testing to ensure compliance with our standards and requirements. AVA will continue to monitor the situation closely.
