



Consumer Advisory – Recall Of McCormick French Onion Dip Mix (0.53-ounce) From USA

The U.S. Food & Drug Administration has issued an alert to inform that McCormick & Company, Incorporated (NYSE:MKC) is initiating a voluntary recall of its products containing hydrolyzed vegetable protein (HVP) supplied by Basic Food Flavors of Las Vegas, Nevada, because the HVP has the potential to be contaminated with Salmonella.

2 The Agri-Food and Veterinary Authority (AVA) has checked and confirmed that one of the implicated products was imported into Singapore. AVA has advised the importers and retailers to recall the implicated product from the market immediately.

3 AVA advises the consumers who have bought the implicated product to discard the product and not to consume them.
