

Consumer Advisory: Recall Of Spring Bay Australian Mussels

21 March 2016: The Food Standards Australia and New Zealand has issued an alert that selected batches of Spring Bay Australian Mussels have been recalled due to contamination with a biotoxin (Diarrhetic Shellfish Toxins). Products contaminated with Diarrhetic Shellfish Toxins may cause illness if consumed. The products are produced by Spring Bay Seafoods Pty Ltd.

2 The Agri-Food and Veterinary Authority (AVA) has confirmed that affected Spring Bay Australian Mussels were imported into Singapore. The importer has completed the recall of the implicated products from the market.

3 Consumers who have purchased the implicated products with the stated use by dates are advised not to consume it. Consumption of products contaminated with Diarrhetic Shellfish Toxins may cause diarrhoea, nausea, vomiting, chills and abdominal pain. Consumers who have consumed the affected products should seek medical advice if they have concerns.
