

Recall of “Bouchot live mussels” from France

The European Commission Rapid Alert System for Food and Feed (RASFF) has issued a recall for “Bouchot live mussels” from France (Baie Du Mont-Saint-Michel Aop) due to presence of norovirus.

2 As some batches of the implicated products were imported into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency has directed the importer, Classic Fine Food(s) Pte Ltd to recall the products. The affected products are no longer available in the market.

3 Consumers who have consumed live mussels and present gastroenteritis symptoms are advised to consult their doctor for medical assistance immediately.
