

Recall of “Daesang brand Rice Seasoning Mixes”


The Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) and the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) of New Zealand have recalled certain Daesang brand rice seasoning mixes due to undeclared allergens such as egg, milk, wheat or oyster.

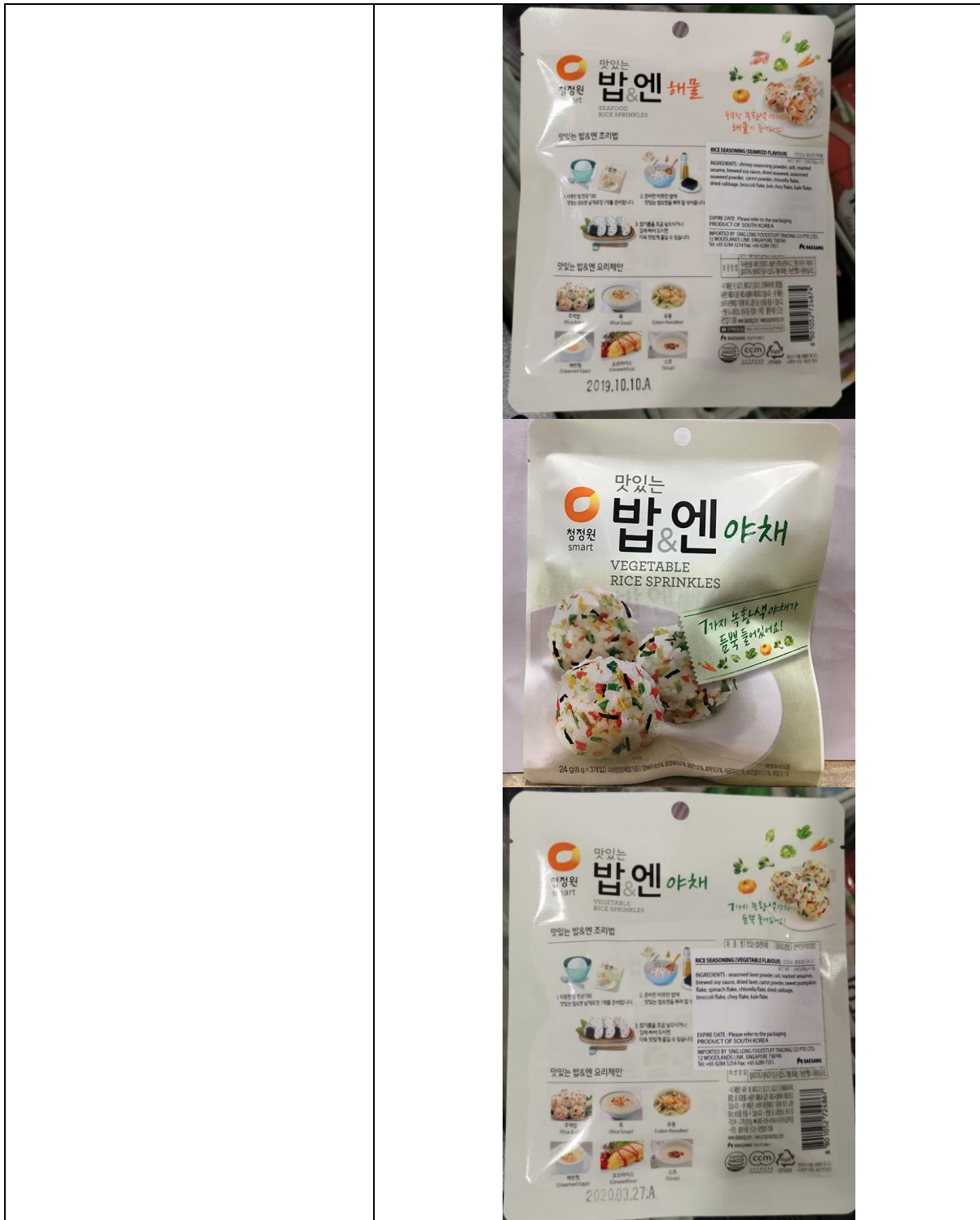
2 As there is import of the implicated products (Daesang Seafood Rice Sprinkles and Vegetable Rice Sprinkles) into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency has directed the importer to recall the products. The recall is complete.

3 Consumers who are allergic to egg, milk, wheat, or oyster should not consume the implicated products. Those who have consumed the implicated products and have concerns about their health should seek medical advice.
