Recall of “Earthen Pot” brand Chilli Powder due to levels of aflatoxins exceeding permitted levels

The Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has detected the presence of aflatoxins exceeding the maximum standards stated in the Singapore Food Regulations in “Earthen Pot” brand Chilli Powder. SFA has directed the manufacturer, Nims Pte Ltd, to recall the implicated batch. The recall is ongoing.

2 Aflatoxins can occur in foods, as a result of fungal contamination before and after harvest under warm and humid conditions. Aflatoxins are known to be genotoxic and carcinogenic, and exposure through food should be kept as low as possible.

3 Consumers who have purchased the implicated product are advised not to consume it. Those who have consumed the implicated product and have concerns about their health should seek medical advice. Consumers may contact their point of purchase for enquiries.


