

Recall of Kiwigarden Coconut Vanilla Dairy Free Yoghurt Drops (10g) from New Zealand due to undeclared milk allergen

Food manufacturer Kiwigarden has voluntarily recalled Kiwigarden’s Coconut Vanilla Dairy Free Yoghurt Drops from New Zealand, due to undeclared milk allergen.

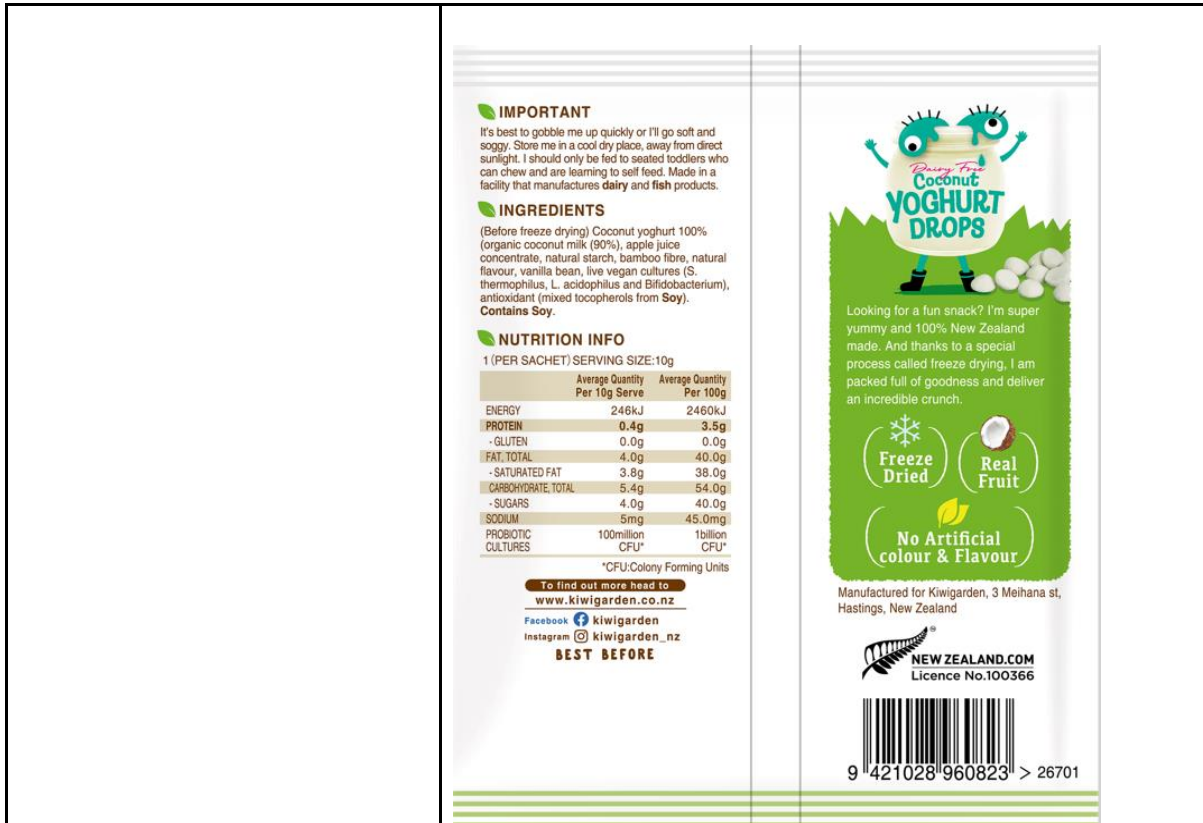
2 As the implicated product was imported into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has directed the importer Optimo Foods Pte Ltd, to recall the implicated product. The recall is ongoing.

3 Allergen in food could result in allergic reaction in individuals who are sensitive to it. Under the Singapore’s Food Regulations, food products containing ingredients that are known to cause hypersensitivity must be declared on the food packaging labels to protect consumers with food allergies.

4 Milk does not pose a food safety issue to consumers at large, except for those who are intolerant or allergic to milk. Consumers who have purchased the implicated product, and who are intolerant of or allergic to milk, should not consume them. Those who are intolerant of or allergic to milk and have consumed the implicated products should seek medical advice if they have concerns about their health. Consumers may contact their point of purchase for enquiries.
