SFA LAUNCHES TENDER FOR 10 LAND PARCELS FOR FOOD FARMING AT LIM CHU KANG

The Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has launched 10 land parcels for food farming at Lim Chu Kang for sale by public tender today:

- 6 land parcels for beansprout farming;
- (ii) 3 land parcels for General Agriculture (Food) farming; and
- (iii) 1 land parcel for vegetable farming
- 2. The land parcels for General Agriculture (Food) farming may be used to farm food crops, seafood, quail eggs, cattle/goats for dairy milk and/or food frogs.
- 3. To achieve our "30-by-30" vision to meet 30 per cent of our nutritional needs locally by 2030, our farms have to make efficient use of scarce resources such as land, water and energy. Farms should leverage technology to increase productivity and be sustainable and resilient against climate change. Proposals that can achieve high production levels sustainably will have a higher chance of being awarded these new land parcels. Proposals will be assessed on their production capability, track record, relevant experience and qualifications as well as innovation and business sustainability including waste management.
